
SYNTHIA YUSUF AUDREY




The Arts Club Theatre Company is proud to partner with the Citadel Theatre for this production of *Little Shop of Horrors*.

In 1986, he wrote and directed the Broadway musical Smile (music by Marvin Hamlisch). 
